In mid-July, we encountered five little, spotted puppies who left us with no choice but to bring them home to HSAR. They had been abandoned in a field on a property in Lassen County, alongside three other adult dogs. These pups were thin and had clearly been left to fend for themselves. Despite their abandonment and neglect, they were incredibly friendly and starved for affection.

On July thirteenth, just four days after their arrival at our facility, it became evident that one of them wasn't feeling well. Our hearts sank when we received a positive parvovirus test result. Parvo is a dreaded term in the rescue world, one we

never want to associate with a dog in our care. It's an aggressive and life-threatening gastrointestinal illness and it's especially hard on puppies. We devised a plan with our veterinarian, opting for an at-home treatment plan to give them the best chance of survival. This involved administering subcutaneous fluids twice daily, numerous medications, an exhaustive cleaning routine, and a considerable amount of concern. Sadly, despite a heroic three-day battle in the animal hospital under round-the-clock care, one of our sweet boys was unable to overcome his illness.

Our remaining four puppies have displayed incredible strength and resilience. They are now in the final

stages of receiving their vaccinations, a crucial step in securing their future health. They have been made available for adoption and will be on the way to their forever homes very soon.

Donations to our urgent campaign helped to cover the costs of medical treatments, additional staff hours, tests, and other essential supplies. We are profoundly grateful for every contribution as it directly impacts the lives of these puppies.

As we navigate through this challenging chapter, we'd like to emphasize the critical importance of vaccinations for the overall health and well-being of pets. We hope that this serves as a life-saving reminder for all to spay/neuter, get age-appropriate vaccinations, and diligently protect your animal's health.
